Also introduction of Song of the Week activity school wide where students get a treat to guess the song and get games over lunch with the Principal and Principal coverage in class as a reward • Fridays after announcements Mr Ennes does positive announcements and the school engages in a dance party and sometimes a dance train through the hallways—good morale booster for students and staff • Chess Team tryouts over last three weeks on lunch hours **Upcoming events/activities** Wellness Walk is coming up and announcements about self-help skills are being promoted for students • Girls Club about Empowerment is starting after March Break and Mrs Piacente and Mr Ennes are hosting.
